



INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME PRELIMINARY SUBJECT CHOICE FORM

Students entering the IBDP need to choose six subjects: THREE at Higher Level (HL) and THREE at Standard Level (SL). Students should opt for HL subjects based on academic strength and a keen interest in those subjects, requirements of institutions of tertiary learning, and the advice of the Leader for Learning and Careers Counsellor. SL subjects cover topics in less depth than HL subjects and are intended to give the IBDP student a well-rounded education.

Students need to choose one subject from each of the six subject groups by filling in the circles next to the subject and then circle HL or SL depending on whether they wish to take the subject at the Higher or Standard Level:

Seven subjects: In exceptional cases students may be allowed to choose a seventh subject as an Extra Certificate subject. This may be taken at Higher or Standard Level. The Leader for Learning, with the advice of the subject teachers, decides whether or not the student has sufficient academic strength to be able to take a seventh subject in the DP.

It is very important to note that the purpose of this Preliminary Subject Choice Form is to help us to determine what Diploma Programme subjects will be on offer in the next academic year. We reserve the right to decide not to offer certain subjects if demand for the subject is low. We will only offer certain subjects if there are enough students to start a class.

Please recognise that a student's choices may result in a timetable conflict, preventing the student from taking both subjects. We will attempt to resolve these conflicts and provide students with advice on alternative subjects if necessary by the end of MYP5.
